

**This week in Early Years.....our topic is**  
**Families (9.5.11)**

<b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</b>	In our SEAL (Social, Emotional Aspects of Learning) session we will continue to think about changes. We will talk about how the people in our families have changed. We will think about why we have rules and about how we should treat other people.
<b>Communication, Language and Literacy Development</b>	We will continue to make an information book about our families. In phonics we will begin to recap on the phonemes ch, sh, th, ai and ee and the words we, me, be, she, and he. We will continue to learn the names of the letters of the alphabet and practice writing each letter correctly.
<b>Mathematical Development</b>	In Maths we will continue to learn about numbers that add together to make ten (Number Bonds) and begin to write number sentences to show what we know. We will explore the subtraction sentences we can learn using our number bonds (e.g. $10-3=7$ ). We will continue to practice counting, recognising and ordering numbers to at least 10.
<b>Knowledge and Understanding of the World</b>	We will talk about our families and how they have changed over time, especially ourselves and the other children in our families. In ICT we will continue to make a booklet about our families.
<b>Physical Development</b>	In PE we will develop our use of games equipment through throwing and catching balls, beanbags and hoops and playing simple games. We will continue to develop our skills in gymnastics, moving in different ways, over, under and around different equipment.
<b>Creative Development</b>	We will continue to explore what we can make both inside and outside using lots of different resources. We will use the instruments to accompany songs and rhymes we know.
