

This week in Early Years...
...our topic is 'Rapunzel'.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We will continue to work hard to follow our rules and to work together as a class to earn points for our chart. We will discuss issues surrounding sharing, turn taking etc. as they arise and will think about how best to deal with them.
Communication, Language and Literacy Development	We will continue to talk about the story of 'Rapunzel' and will share other stories with princesses/knights as characters. In our phonics sessions we will learn about the sound 'ck' e.g. pick and to recognise the tricky word 'to'. We will begin to use our tricky words when reading and writing simple captions e.g. to Rapunzel/to the prince.
Mathematical Development	We will continue building towers this week and will practise using words such as taller, shorter etc. We will use equipment in the classroom to make things of different lengths/heights and will order objects from shortest to tallest/longest.
Knowledge and Understanding of the World	We will continue to find out about castles/towers and who lives in them and will change our role play area into a castle. We will continue to talk about hair/plaiting and will be visited by Beverly's mum who will show us how she plaits Beverly's hair and plait the children's hair if they would like! We will make our first visit to the ICT suite on Tuesday where we will learn to log on and off the computers and make firework pictures.
Physical Development	We will continue to practise controlling our actions on command in PE. We will continue to try to hold and organise ribbons whilst plaiting and will also practise the formation of our new sounds and tricky words.
Creative Development	We will continue to make and decorate a variety of hats relating to princesses/knights/princes etc. We will learn a song about a princess and will try to add our own actions.
