

**This week in Early Years.....our topic is**  
**Shelters (28.3.11)**

<b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</b>	In SEAL we will be thinking about what we are good at and what we would like to do better. We will continue to reinforce class rules and routines and begin to understand why they are important.
<b>Communication, Language and Literacy Development</b>	We will be looking at a non-fiction book about shelters and recapping on how to use a contents and index page from last week's guided reading sessions. We will continue to make our own non-fiction books about Spring. In phonics we will be learning the phonemes 'er' as in <u>summer</u> and 'ure' (pronounced 'your') as in <u>pure</u> . We will learn to read the tricky word 'all'.
<b>Mathematical Development</b>	In Maths we will practise recalling one more and one less than all numbers to at least ten. We will continue to learn about positional language e.g. next to, behind, underneath, on top of. We will continue to practise counting, reading and writing numbers.
<b>Knowledge and Understanding of the World</b>	This week we will look at the different shelters people use in hot countries and compare them to the shelters people use in cold countries. In ICT we will continue using 2publish to write a postcard from a hot place.
<b>Physical Development</b>	In PE we will develop our throwing and catching skills and continue to use the large apparatus to climb safely and link movements together. We will continue to develop our skills with large equipment in the outdoor area. We will continue to practise our letter and number formation.
<b>Creative Development</b>	We will make shelters in construction and paint pictures of different shelters. We will continue to enjoy our beach role play area.
