

This week in Early Years.....our topic is
How I have changed (16.5.11)

Personal, Social and Emotional Development	In our SEAL (Social, Emotional Aspects of Learning) session we will continue to think about changes. We will talk about how we have changed since we were babies and also talk about how important it is to look after ourselves so that we grow.
Communication, Language and Literacy Development	We will finish making our information book about our families. In phonics we will recap on the phonemes igh, oi, oo and ou and the tricky words we have already learnt. We will continue to learn the names of the letters of the alphabet and practice writing each letter correctly.
Mathematical Development	In Maths we will continue to practise subtraction by learning a new song called 'The biscuit tin.' We will talk about the number sentences which describe what happens in the song and explore what happens when we take different numbers away.
Knowledge and Understanding of the World	We will talk about how we grow and change and the importance of eating healthily, exercising and looking after ourselves. We will have the opportunity to pay 20p to try a new piece of fruit on Wednesday. In ICT we will finish our booklets about our families.
Physical Development	In PE we will develop our use of games equipment through aiming with ball and beanbags and playing simple games. We will continue to develop our skills in gymnastics, moving in different ways, over, under and around different equipment.
Creative Development	We will create collages of ourselves using different materials, looking closely at the colour and style of our hair and the colour of our eyes.
