

This week in Early Years.....our topic is
Spring/Class Assembly (21.3.11)

Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We will be reinforcing the rules of the classroom and why we have them. In SEAL we will be thinking about what we are good at and what we would like to do better. We will take part in our second class assembly.
Communication, Language and Literacy Development	We will be looking at non-fiction books both as a whole class and in guided reading. We will look at the contents and index pages and learn how to use them. In phonics we will be learning the phonemes 'ear' as in hear and 'air' as in chair. We will learn to read the tricky word 'her'.
Mathematical Development	In Maths we will begin to look at subtraction number sentences by investigating what happens when we share flowers between two vases. E.g. when we start with 10 flowers and put 4 in one and 6 in the other, we will write $10-4=6$. We will begin to learn about positional language e.g. next to, behind, underneath, on top of.
Knowledge and Understanding of the World	This week we will look at Spring and the changes that happen to the trees, flowers, weather etc. In ICT we will continue using 2publish to write a postcard from a hot place.
Physical Development	We will use our PE hall times to practise our class assembly. We will play games with our bats, balls etc in the outdoor area. We will continue to practise our letter and number formation.
Creative Development	We will make daffodil pictures using egg boxes and will investigate mixing colours.
