This week in Year 1 we will be:

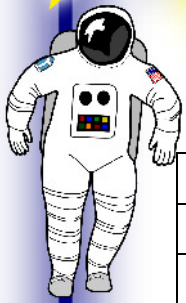
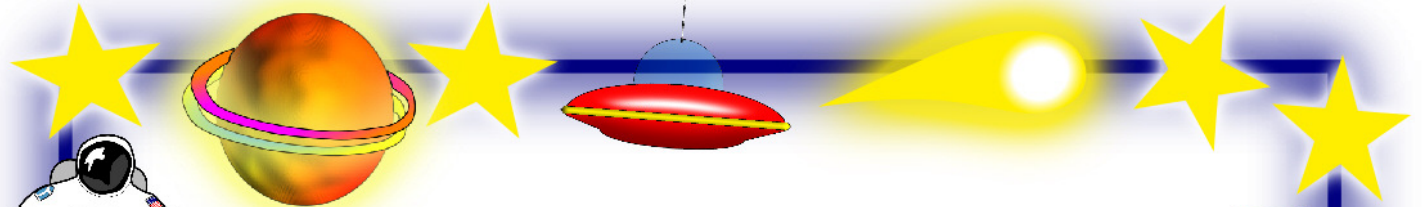
- Starting back at school on Tuesday

Maths

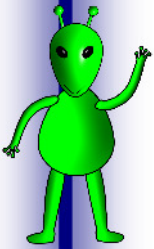
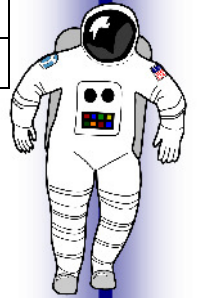
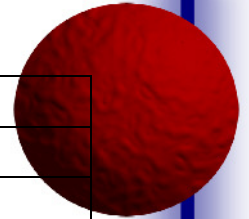
We will be using balance scales to compare weights, starting to look at and compare capacities, collecting information in block graphs, recalling addition facts and comparing/ordering numbers.
