This week in Year 1 we will be:

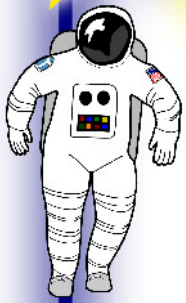
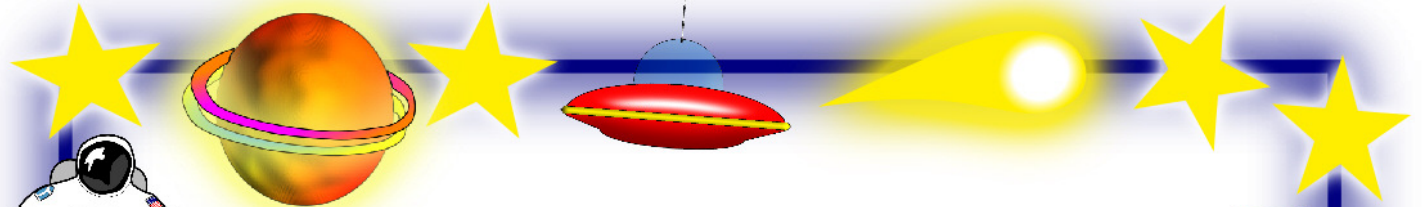
- Taking part in Children's Book Week (more information on <http://www.booktrust.org.uk/show/feature/About-Childrens-Book-Week>)

Homework task: Practise number bonds to 10.

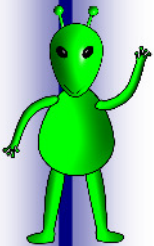
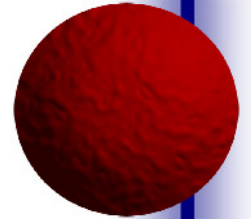
Find a visual way of representing a bond to 10 for example: a picture of a planet with 4 craters on it



and 6 stars in the sky behind. Record this as a number sentence. Share on Friday!

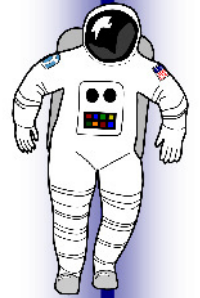

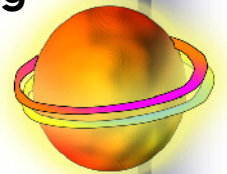
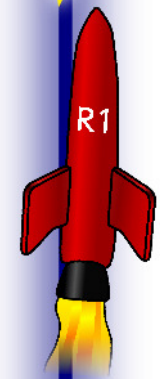


English
