


This term's topic

<p><u>PE</u> Year 1 will be developing their hitting and skipping skills in games. In gym, the unit is about finding different ways of travelling. In Year 2 the focus is on group games and inventing rules. In gym the unit is about spinning, twisting and turning.</p>		<p><u>Maths</u> The children in both year groups will continue to build on previous learning, further developing their understanding of number operations, problem solving, data handling, shape, space and measure through a range of activities, both written and practical.</p>
<p><u>ICT</u> In Year 2 we are developing our keyboard skills and learning how to send emails. In Year 1 we are also developing our keyboard skills - adding text to images.</p>		<p><u>RE/PSHE</u> We are thinking about promises we make in our lives. This will include looking at The Lord's Prayer in Christianity and promises made at weddings (linked to the Royal wedding).</p>
<p><u>Science</u> Year 1 will be learning about different materials, how to describe them and sort them according to their properties. We will also be carrying out an investigation to see which materials would make the best umbrella for a king or queen.</p> <p>In year 2 we are looking at grouping and changing materials. This will include an investigation to test how much water different materials hold.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u> Year 1 are going to be looking at traditional and fairy stories, including writing their own version of Cinderella. There will be lots of opportunities for role play and drama.</p> <p>Year 2 will be writing their own extended stories based on 'The Magic Finger' by Roald Dahl. They will write their own version, about a child with magical powers.</p> <p><u>Music</u> We will be composing music for a royal procession.</p>	<p><u>History</u> We are learning about kings and queens in relation to the present day royal family and then in Year 2 creating a timeline of British kings and queens.</p> <p><u>Art/Design and Technology</u> The children will be looking at portraits of British kings and queens and then creating their own royal portrait. In DT they will be designing and making a wooden spoon puppet wearing clothes fit for a royal ball choosing appropriate materials and decorations.</p>
